- Monitor and report to the Board on the financial health of the organisation;

- A theatre with soul, history, and potential;
- A committed and collegial Board of Trustees;
- An opportunity to shape the cultural life in the region;
- The chance to leave a lasting legacy in Ayrshire's arts landscape.
